Each laboratory should avoid "Three Cs" (closed spaces, crowded places, and close-contact settings) to prevent infection. Student ID and body temperature check is conducted at the campus entrances.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Level 1 – ③</p> <p>Taking the thorough infection prevention measures and the basic policies and guidelines on class implementation set by the university, most of the classes are conducted face-to-face while "online classes" are conducted partially.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Level 1 – ②</p> <p>Students who meet the following conditions (including external students) will be allowed to enter the campus for activities with university permission. The permission may be revoked if you violate the conditions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Students who belong to the groups that the university admitted and external students who participate in matches. •Students who attend a presentation or a concert. •Students who prepare for the online harvest festival. •The activities held on the condition of taking preventive measures against COVID-19 and well scheduled. •External students should follow the infection preventive measures set by the university. •Plan well and apply appropriate prevention measures to each activity. | <p style="text-align: center;">Level 1</p> <p>On the condition of taking preventive measures against COVID-19, administrative offices open for services.</p> |
