### 2024 Information Sheet for Visiting Students

You must obtain a Student Visa to study at Tokyo NODAI. You need a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to apply for your visa at the Japanese Embassy or consulate in your country. Your visa's term of validity is the same as the length of your study term at Tokyo NODAI.

Certificate of Eligibility (COE)

The COE is an official document issued by the Japanese Ministry of Justice.

THIS CERTIFICATE DOES NOT REPLACE A STUDENT VISA.

Center for Global Initiative applies for your COE on your behalf and sends it to you when issued. You will need to use the certificate and a valid passport to apply for a Student Visa at a Japanese embassy or consulate.

Consult with the Japanese Embassy/Consulate for any supporting documents.

The COE will be sent by email 1-2 months before your arrival.
