earned his bachelor's degree from the **University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA)**, a **Master's degree in Rangeland Studies** from **Texas Tech University**, and a **Ph.D. in Geography** from the **University of Oxford**. He is currently a **Senior Research Fellow** at the **School of Geography and the Environment, University of Oxford**, where he specializes in the geography of arid lands, climate change, and pastoral societies. He is also a **Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society**.

Dr. Sternberg has conducted **innovative research** for many years on the **sustainability and disaster resilience of nomadic societies**, focusing particularly on the **Gobi Desert in Mongolia and Central Asia**. His work has significantly contributed to the integration of **geographical and social sciences**, and his findings have had **practical impacts** on local communities and policy development.
