

Application Procedure for Tokyo University of Agriculture "Emergency Student Assistance Scholarship"

The "Emergency Student Assistance Scholarship" will be provided as follows.

Following the application procedure below, please register your bank account information for the payment.

<Eligibility> To be a regular undergraduate student of Tokyo University of Agriculture (enrolled as of May 1)

<Amount of the Scholarship> 50,000 yen per student

<Application procedure>

- 1) Log in on the Student Portal Website and register the necessary information, such as bank name and account number of your bank account.
- 2) The remittance destination account has to be under the name of the student himself / herself. If you don't have any, please open one.
- 3) Only accounts of Japanese banks can be registered as the remittance destination.
- 4) Take a photo of the document which shows 1) name of the bank, 2) account number, and 3) name of the account holder, such as bank card or a screen of Internet Banking, and upload its' data on the registration site. It will be used to confirm the account information when necessary. Incomplete registration may cause a delay in the remittance.
